

This year marks the 5th Annual Tamkin Symposium. The Tamkin gift was bestowed by Dr. Jerome Tamkin and his wife Judith to support the University of California, Irvine College of Medicine Education Program. Thanks to this gift, we are able to dedicate this annual symposium to medical and health care issues presented by speakers who are distinguished in their field. The audience for the Tamkin Symposium is customarily students, faculty, area physicians, business leaders, and other professionals, as well as residents of Orange County and the surrounding area.
